

Subj: 2021 MARINE CORPS JUNIOR ROTC R2/R5 DRILL COMPETITION

1. The Woodlands College Park High School will host the R2/R5 MCJROTC Drill Competition which will be held at Hyatt Regency St Louis At The Arch on 8 May 2021. The venue is located at 315 Chestnut St, St Louis, MO 63102. The MCJROTC phone number is (909) 440-0653, or email cody.stewart@mcjrotc.org.
2. The meet will consist of the events listed below. Team composition is up to the competing school's discretion; therefore, personnel can fluctuate between regulation and exhibition.
 - a. Inspection (Best 10 Cadets in platoon formation)
 - c. Regulation Drill (armed 100x75)
 - d. Regulation Drill (unarmed 100x75)
 - e. Exhibition Drill (armed 100x75)
 - f. Exhibition Drill (unarmed 100x75)
 - g. Color Guard (60x70)
3. Schools may enter a maximum of one armed and one unarmed drill team. The teams will compete equally for the trophies in their event, armed or unarmed. Schools may enter one color guard. Schools must enter a team in each category to compete toward the overall competition trophies. **All regulation and exhibition drill will have a minimum of 12 cadets in the formation and 1 unit leader.**
4. The overall meet trophies (1st, 2nd, and 3rd) will be awarded to the units with the highest number of combined points in inspection, regulation drill (armed and unarmed), exhibition drill (armed and unarmed), and Color Guard.
5. **The judges' meeting will be held at 0700.** Instructors are not required to attend.
6. Competition will commence at 0800. A detailed schedule will be published when meet participants are finalized.
7. Judging will be JROTC Instructors from Regions 1 and 4.

8. The tie-breaker for regulation drill events and color guard will be the commander's score; for exhibition events it will be the overall impression; for inspection, the overall impression.
9. Hotel rooms will be available as dressing rooms. Restrooms are available in the Hotel. Absolutely, no food or drink inside the drill areas.
10. A concession stand may be available, in addition to drill meet t-shirts for purchase.
11. Cadets should remain in hotel unless supervised by their instructors. Instructors will wear utilities with sleeves up.
12. Trophies and medals will be awarded at the awards ceremony at 2000. If you will not be available to receive trophies, it is your responsibility to make arrangements to obtain the trophy.
13. Instructors are allowed to listen to debriefs with cadets, but will not talk to judges and should not approach a judge at any time during the competition or that team for that event will be disqualified. Any issues should be taken up with the Regional Directors.
14. Entry fee for the drill competition will be \$1,300 per school. Payment must be made prior to the event. Checks should be made payable to TWCP MCJROTC BOOSTER CLUB.
